Celebration of International Year of Millets IYM2023








ACHIEVEMENTS

IIM Lucknow's Prof Anirban Chakraborty and PhD Scholar Sk Abu Khalek from Marketing area received two ABDC A Category publications. Their first publication titled 'Access or collaboration?: A typology of sharing economy' delineates various modes of shared consumption relying on exchange theory and highlights the importance to view the sharing economy as a broad concept while defining eight modes of shared consumption. The second publication titled 'Shared Consumption and its Determinants: A Systematic Literature Review and Future Research Agenda' systematically reviews the extant literature on the adoption of shared consumption, synthesizes the body of knowledge and provides a comprehensive understanding of this emerging consumption mode.

IIM Lucknow's PhD Scholar, Nishant Garg, has secured the coveted Fetzer MSR Scholarship. His proposal was selected amongst the top 20 applications from the research scholars and young faculty applicants across the world, by the MSR Fetzer Scholarship Committee, to attend the Management, Spirituality, and Religion (MSR) program at the 2023 Academy of Management.

Dr. Payal Mehra, from IIM Lucknow's area of Business Communication won the Best Paper award at the Second Annual PRISM Conference held at IIM Nagpur in November 2022. Her paper titled 'When Business Leaders apologize on social media: Evaluating role of Image restoration theory and rhetorical persuasion in crisis management' evaluated the role of 150 public apologies by CEOs and how classical communication theories played a vital role in them. The 2022 edition of PRISM conference was held in memory of Dr. Pritam Singh, former Director of IIM Lucknow.

IIM Lucknow's Prof. Anadi Saran Pande (Strategic Management) and Vivek Kumar Jha (PhD Scholar, Strategic Management) won the Best Paper award at the International Conference on People, Ecosystems, & Emerging Trends in Entrepreneurship held at IIM Kashipur in December 2022.

Their paper titled 'Ecosystems and Sustainability: The Influence of Entrepreneurial Ecosystems on Sustainable Entrepreneurship and SDG Performance of Nations' analysed a large data set comprising 4471 firms across 77 nations in examining the antecedents of sustainability performance of nations.

The conference was organised jointly by IIM Kashipur and Strathclyde Business School, United Kingdom.

Professor Suresh K. Jakhar, in collaboration with IIT Kanpur, designed the Airport Slot allocation algorithm. Using actual data from Delhi and Chennai Airport, they demonstrated that their approach is better than all available rules worldwide.



Prof. <u>Dhirendra Mani Shukla</u> co-authored a publication in the prestigious FT50 Journal of Business Venturing.

The paper titled 'Social entrepreneurship and intersectionality: Mitigating extreme exclusion' contributes to the area of social entrepreneurship by examining social enterprises' efforts to share knowledge in rural areas.

Using a two-step, multi-method approach, the paper discusses how these enterprises seek to mitigate some of the consequences of women's marginalisation during this process.



The paper titled "The Role of Platform in Financing the Capital-Constrained Farmers in Developing Economies" co-authored by our PhD student Mohit Ray with Prof. Suresh K. Jakhar, faculty in the Operations Management area at <u>IIM Lucknow</u> and Prof. Prashant Chintapalli, faculty in the Management Science area at Ivey Business School, London, Ontario, Canada, won the Best Paper award in the "Role of Digital Technology in Reshaping Business" track at POMS India International Conference 2022, organized by POMS India Chapter and IIM Kozhikode from 21-23 December 2022.
