

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

- a) Prof. Neerja Pande, faculty IIM Lucknow conducted an interactive session with MGN Fellows on essentials of report writing and elements of critical thinking.
- b) A feedback session with fellows was conducted by Prof. Ajay Garg and Prof. Kshitij Awasthi, Programme Directors, MGNF, IIM Lucknow on the monthly essays submitted with special emphasis on correct citation and referencing.



STATE ENGAGEMENT

- a) IIM Lucknow is continuously engaging with State Skill Development Missions and District Officials for effective implementation of programme on ground.
- b) Interactive orientation sessions organised by SSDMs of all four States(Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Mizoram and Uttar Pradesh) with fellows and district officials of their respective States to discuss the key aspects of the program and specific roles and responsibilities of various stakeholders in ensuring the effective engagement of fellows.



SPECIAL INITIATIVES

- a) Interactive session of all fellows at IIM Lucknow with Fellows from Phase 1 for sharing of experiences and learnings
- b) A Monitoring Framework with key indicators both for the Academic Module and District Immersion module of the programme has been designed to ensure quality assurance in the programme management.
- c) Creation of buddy network of fellows where the fellows are paired (based on proximity of districts) with each other to promote partnership, cooperation and collaboration.
- d) Interaction with fellows from aspirational districts to create awareness on aspirational districts programme by NITI Aayog and role that the fellows can play in improving the skill related indicators.
- e) An online Gender Sensitisation Workshop titled "Creating Respectable Workplaces for all Individuals" conducted for fellows
