Eligibility Criteria



- Faculty from Regular/ Permanent Faculty at recognized institutes (centrally funded institutes, state public university and private HEIs) duly nominated by the Directors/ Vice Chancellor.
- Preference will be given to faculties of CFIs, however up to 50% participants from State Public Funded Universities and up to 4 faculty members from private HEIs will be allowed in a batch.

Financial Norms



- The programme shall be funded entirely by the Ministry of Education.
- If any institution nominates more than 2 participants in a host institution, the full cost shall be borne by the participant's institution for those additional participants

3. Personal & Interpersonal Module: *This module focusses the behavioral aspects of the leaders. The topics include:*


