Eligibility Criteria for Post-Doctoral Fellowship:

- i. Applicants must have a consistently good academic record and demonstrated research potential. Candidates with a Ph.D. Degree or who have submitted their thesis for the Ph.D. degree may also apply. The thesis must be on the topic related to happiness/positive psychology/ emotional intelligence /subjective wellbeing/ self-esteem/ healing therapy/mindfulness or related domains.
- ii. The PDF applicant should have published at least one A or two B category (as per ABDC 2022 listing) research papers OR the prevailing journal ranking system at the institute in the past two years from the date of application.
- iii. The age limit for applicants for the Post-Doctoral Fellowship will be a maximum of 40 years.

Task and responsibilities of the selected candidate: The PDF is expected to

- i. carry out research on the topic related to happiness and publish article(s) based on the same,
- ii. design and conduct workshops, and take sessions on Happiness and related topics for the stakeholders of IIML,
- iii. engage in activities contributing to the development of the Centre, etc.

Compensations and Benefits: The PDF would receive a fellowship of Rs.80,000/-, along with an accommodation by the institute. In case of non-availability of accommodation inside the campus, the fellow will receive HRA as per the institute norms.
